## Peter Lea-Cox - "Lecosaldi"

A native of Bournemouth, England, Peter Lea-Cox studied at the Royal Academy of Music in London. He later joined the staff at the Royal Academy where he taught choral conducting, sight-singing, harmony and other subjects for 14 years.

From 1987 to 2004 Peter served as Cantor (Director of Music) at the Lutheran Church of St. Anne & St. Agnes built by Christopher Wren in 1680 in the City of London. During this time, he completed performances of all 220 Bach cantatas with the Lecosalidi Ensemble, a group of professional singers and instrumentalists he founded.

Peter is an accomplished recitalist who made his 24th recital tour to Denmark in May 2011. He has given organ recitals at St. Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey in London as well as at Washington's National Cathedral. Peter was guest conductor of De Swaen Barokensemble in Amsterdam in January 2011. He conducts the Camden Chamber Choir in London and other choral groups as well as serving as a full-time tutor for singers and instrumentalists at the annual Oxford Baroque Week.

He has composed many vocal and instrumental works as well as compositions for organ. He uses the pseudonym "Pietro Lecosalidi" when composing in the baroque style of Handel and Telemann. He uses "Lea-Cox" when composing in a contemporary idiom.

Gillian Humphreys Lea-Cox, Peter's wife, who usually accompanies her husband on musical tours, is a soprano and a piano teacher who studied at the Royal Academy of Music. She is also an accomplished potter.
